HISTORIC NEWSPAPERS ONLINE

The State Historical Society of Missouri has announced the addition of new digitized Missouri newspaper titles. The Missouri Digital Newspaper Project includes 135 newspaper titles representing 74 of Missouri's counties and the city of St. Louis. To date, the program has digitized approximately 600,000 unique pages. They can be accessed by visiting the Society's website at <http://shs.umsystem.edu/newspaper/mdnp>. Here you will find the Tusculumbia Osage Valley Banner 1879-1881.

Many of Missouri's digital newspapers are also available through the Library of Congress's Chronicling America site (<http://chroniclingamerica.loc.gov>), which offers historic newspapers from across the country.

OLD MEDICAL TERMS

Scrofula	Also known as King's Evil; tuberculosis of the lymph glands in the neck. This occurred from drinking tuberculous milk.
Water Brash	Pyrosis; heartburn; a burning sensation in the esophagus and stomach, with sour belching of a thin, watery fluid
Wind Colic	Pain in the bowels due to their distention with air or gas
Yellow Fever	Also called Yellow Jack; An acute infectious disease caused by a bite of an infected mosquito. Symptoms include chills, fever, pains, aches, jaundice, kidney damage, vomiting, uremia, and in many cases death.
