If you receive your newsletter via USPS, tickets are enclosed. If you receive your newsletter via e-mail, tickets are attached to the e-mail.

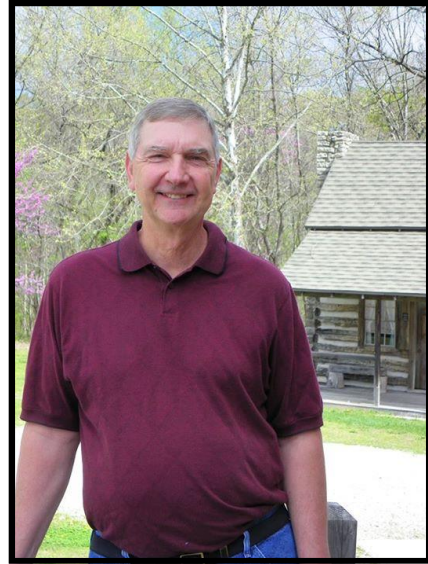

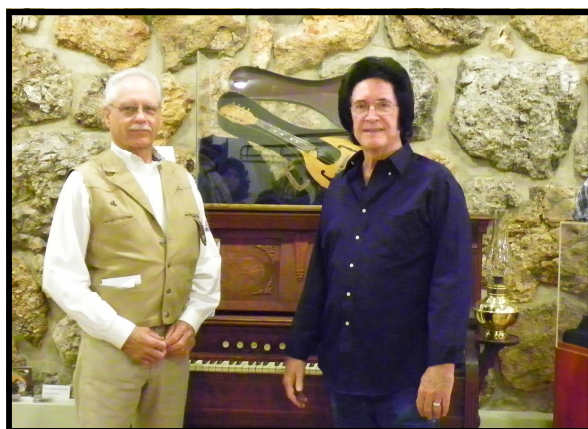
Cindy Hart, also a retired educator, was elected to serve on the Board of Directors. Cindy lives in the Gageville area.

#### SELECTIVE SERVICEô Thursday, May 9, 1968, Autogram-Sentinel

Scheduled for induction on May 21 are Ralph William Nowack, Frank P. George Jr., Roger Dale Plemmons, Michael Douglas Prather, Marvin Ray Bunch, Dwight Wayne Barnett, Harry Arthur Luke, Sherrill Gene Duncan, Rachard Glen Meeks and Jesse Wayne Boatman.

Ten will be sent for physical examination on the same date.

Of the 16 sent for induction on April 29, three were inducted into the Marine Corps, 10 into the Army, two failed to pass the physical examination and one was held over for further examination. Only three of the 13 sent for physical examination were accepted as physically fit for induction.
