U S I N G O N L I N E I M A G E S

An exciting part of researching one's ancestors is discovering photos of them online. Most photos taken before 1923 are in the public domain, though the original may be owned by a library or museum and they may license its use. When searching image collections, look for information about usage or rights and reproductions. Many repositories will allow you to download an image for personal use but require a licensing fee for publishing it (such as in a family history book or on a website). When in doubt, it is always best to contact the repository for clarification. Always credit the source of the image, even if there are no usage restrictions.

Images taken by government agencies, such as the Farm Security Administration, are generally all right to use however you wish, but be sure to check the online image details for confirmation.

When you find an image someone has attached to his or her online family tree contact the submitter for permission before using it.
